

PRESS NOTE

The prospectus for admission to two years Diploma Course in Elementary Education is available in the office of the Principal, District Institute of Education & Training (DIET) Porvorim-Goa from 14th March 2017 to 10th April, 2017 **between 10.00 a.m. to 4.00 p.m.** The last date for the submission of the duly completed application form is 17th April, 2017. The applications received after due date will not be taken into consideration.

The minimum qualification required for admission is XIIth passed (10+2 pattern) The minimum percentage of XIIth Std. is 50% marks.

Those who have appeared for Std. XII examinations may also apply for the D.El.Ed. Course.

Eligibility

A candidate seeking admission to the Diploma in Education (D.El.Ed.) Course should:

- Be resident of Goa state for last 15 years
- Have passed 10 + 2 pattern (Higher Secondary general stream Arts/Science/Commerce) in **single attempt** only.
- Have passed 10 + 2 Pattern with MARATHI at H.S.S.C.E. (Std XII) to apply for MARATHI MEDIUM D. El.Ed. Course.
- Have 50% and above aggregate percentage at Higher Secondary level.
- Should have the following elementary school based subject at Higher Secondary level.
 1. English with minimum 45% Marks and 40% for SC/ST (compulsory).
 2. Hindi / Marathi / Konkani / Sanskrit / Kannada / Urdu (Any one)
 3. Mathematics,/Physics/Chemistry / Biology /Computer Science/ History/Geography/Political Science/Sociology/Psychology/Economics (Any one)
